EBSOMED is a 4-year project co-financed at 80% by the European Union through the EuropeAid Programme for a global amount of EUR 6 million. It aims to boost private business and Business Networks in the Southern Neighbourhood. The project is implemented by a public-private alliance.

MedaWomen is a great opportunity for women to exchange challenges, talk about changing women's roles, the rapidly changing dynamics in the social and economic areas in the Mediterranean and provide solutions for businesswomen.
