

# Meet the Employers' Group



### What is the EESC?

- It is a consultative body comprising 350 members from the 28 EU
   Member States, representing civil society organisations.
- Members are appointed for a renewable five-year term by the Council
  on a proposal by Member States, but they work independently for the
  EESC in the interest of all EU citizens.

#### What is the role of EESC?

It has three main tasks, which are to:

- ensure that EU policies reflect the true economic, social and civic picture,
- build a more participatory EU, closer to its citizens, and
- promote EU values and civil society organisations globally



## An assembly consisting of three Groups

### **Group I – Employers**

- Representatives of business associations working in industry, commerce, services and agriculture in the 28 Member States of the European Union
- President: Jacek Krawczyk

#### **Group II – Workers**

Representatives of national trade unions, confederations and sectoral federations

#### **Group III – Various interests**

• Other representatives of and stakeholders in civil society, particularly in the economic, civic, professional and cultural spheres

### **Publications**


• **Preparation of studies and position papers** in collaboration with prestigious think-tanks

## **Preparing Opinions**

- Members identify both the strengths and weaknesses of EU legislation taking due account of the needs and expectations of employers from all Member States.
- According to their area of expertise and interests, members work within the six sections of the EESC, the CCMI
   (Consultative Commission on Industrial Change) and the 3 Observatories (Single Market Observatory, Sustainable Development Observatory, Labour Market Observatory)



## Lifecycle of an opinion

Request for an opinion

Rapporteur works on draft opinion with Study Group

Seeking consensus within the Section

Draft opinion voted at the Section level

Vote during the Plenary Session. Opinion published

Follow-up with stakeholders and decision makers

## **Opinions**

- Referrals: major work of the EESC, drafted upon request of the European Commission/the EU Presidency based on ongoing legislative proposals;
- Exploratory opinions: requested by the EU institutions on topics that the EESC has particular expertise in;
- Own-initiative opinions: topics decided by the EESC Bureau based on Groups and Sections proposals.





### **Events**

- Thematic conferences and seminars related to Groups' priorities;
- High-level speakers: ministers, MEPs, EC representatives, academics, entrepreneurs with hands-on experience;
- Organised both in Brussels and in EU Member States (including countries of the EU Presidency).



### **Publications**

- Issuing studies in cooperation with prestigious think-tanks and EU affairs research centres. Recent studies:
  - ✓ Implementation of better legislation Effect of the Stoiber Report (EPC);
  - ✓ Factors for Growth (Lighthouse Europe);
- Position papers prepared as a follow-up after the events;
- Monthly newsletters.



## **Cooperation**

- Strong partnerships with Europe's major business organisations, (i.e. BUSINESSEUROPE, CEEP, EUROCHAMBRES, EuroCommerce and UEAPME), and with national employers organisations across the 28 Member States;
- Cooperation with employers' organisations in non-EU countries (Eastern Partnership, Japan, US);



**How?** Organisation of **joint events**, **public hearings** and **seminars**, as well as on permanent **sharing of information** related to current activities.
